



## Expectations, Procedures and Guidelines Math 6Y -- Mr. Smith, 2009-2010

### Communication

### Class Materials/Preparation

*Required materials every day!*

- 3-ring binder with filler paper (with holes)
- 4 dividers for binder (notes, homework, etc.)
- Composition Book (for P.O.D. and will be kept in room)
  - I will provide these for you!
- Small amount of graph paper (kept in binder)
- Textbook and Workbook
- Pencil (no pens!)
- Planner (will receive from NYA)

### Homework

- Due at beginning of class for 2 pts.
- Done with *proper heading (see back page)* and kept in three ring binder.
- Incomplete homework results in *7<sup>th</sup> Period*.
- Late unexcused homework will follow the following rules:
  - Day 1 - lose 1 point & 7<sup>th</sup> Period
  - Day 2 - lose 1 point & 7<sup>th</sup> Period

*\*Note:* 6<sup>th</sup> Graders receive a month “grace period” for academic detentions at the beginning of the year. If incomplete or missing a homework assignment during the month of September, 6<sup>th</sup> graders will still fill out a detention form but will not serve the detention. As of October 5<sup>th</sup>, the “grace period” will be over and all detentions will be served as received.
- Random weekly or bi-weekly homework collections for a grade.

### Tests and Quizzes

- Test will be announced in advance - quizzes may or may not be.
- The day before a test is often a review day to help prepare.
- All tests and quizzes will be sent home for parent review and a signature.

### Prepared for Class

- Follow list (next to homework board) stating what you need for class every day.
- Certain days may require other materials brought to class.
- If unprepared for class 3 times in a month, a detention is assigned.

## Class Participation

- **All** students are expected to participate and give best efforts!
- Participation, effort and behavior contribute to a quiz-size grade each trimester.

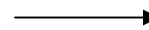
## How you are graded!

- Projects, tests, quizzes, homework, P.O.D. checks, and participation all contribute to your class grade.

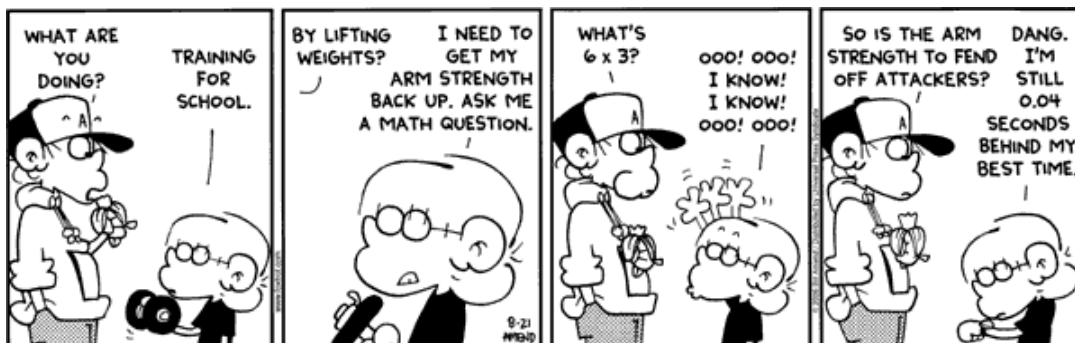
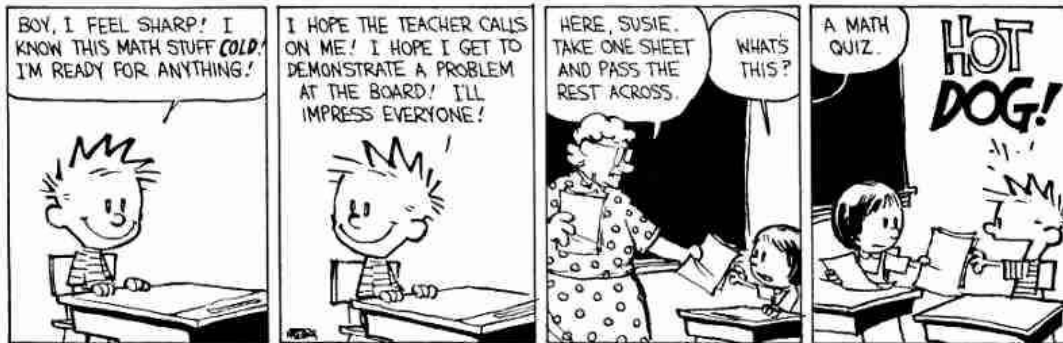
## Hint...
